The Port Macquarie Cycling Club was formed by Graham Seers in 1988.

It was originally formed in an association of Road cyclists and Triathlon enthusiasts in the Port Macquarie area and was known as The Port Macquarie Tri / Cycle Club.

The foundation president was Fred Goggins a triathlon enthusiast.

The club formation required a minimum 10 members at start up and within 12 months the club had over 100 members.

In 1992 the club membership split with the Tri athletes and Road cyclists going their separate ways.

The Port Macquarie Cycle Club was reincorporated in 1992 and Murray Sallaway was elected President.

The club foundation colours were Pantone Magenta, Black and white, with an image of Port Macquaries Norfolk pine.

Over the years PMCC have produced riders of all age groups representing our club on both road and track at State, National and International level.

The club has honoured a number of members for service to Port Macquarie Cycle Club.
